NEW FITASC WORLD SPORTING CHAMPION, DERRICK MEIN JOINS TEAM AGUILA

His list of accomplishments includes winning over a dozen Junior Championships, being named Kansas State Champion 11 times, NSCA All-American 8 times, selected for many Gold Medal Teams and the Sydney, Australia World Cup Team, USHA Helice National Champion, Krieghoff Kup Champion and Copa Aguila 2015 Champion, and first place at the Nad Al Sheba Desert Shooting Competition in Dubai to name a few.
